

Here you can find answers to all your questions about internships in Vancouver



Who can participate?

This program is designed for students at the minimum age of 19 years. Participants should be able to speak, read and understand conversational English.

Who does operate the program?

Vancouver Internships Program is operated by a reputable Canadian company English Bay College, EBC. EBC is an accredited member with the Canadian Association of Private Language Schools, The Vancouver Board of Trade, The British Columbia Chamber of Commerce and International Student Safety Program.

How long does the program last?

Minimal 8 weeks (4 weeks- English course, 4 weeks- internship) - maximal 48 weeks.

When is the program available?

All year long, you can start any Monday of the year.

When should I apply?

A minimum 12 weeks before the desired start date.

Do I have to pass any English test?

Yes, but it is much more an assessment than a test. It will help to rank your English. It takes only 20 minutes and 5 minutes telephone interview.

What information will I receive before departure?

Consultations, brochures, detailed information about program, informational manual about Canada, assistance with the visa application, accommodation details, pre-departure information brochure.

Is there an airport pick-up?

Yes, if you decide to book the pick-up as it is an optional service.

How does the accommodation in Vancouver look like?

You will know every detail about accommodation before your arrival to Canada. You will live in a host family, having a private room, 3 meals per day and your housing will be located within 30 minutes of downtown.

How much should I pay for accommodation?

Homestay accommodation costs \$27 CAD per day.

Is this program legal?

Yes. You will study and take internship legally with Study and Work Permit (C30 Exemption) for the entire period of your program.

What is the procedure of choosing the internship location?

Before your arrival to Canada you will be telephonically contacted by your program provider. The final internship choice depends on your requirements, working experiences and skills. Should you or your university have special requirements for internship placement, let us know in advance to discuss the criteria and organize suitable internship placement for you.

In which area can I intern?

You have many options where to take your internship: accounting, finance, marketing & sales, human resources, logistics, general office administration, event management, engineering, tourism, architecture, civil engineering, information technology, media, journalism and many more

What will be my internship in company like?

After signing the contract you will become full member of your host company. This job includes evaluation of weekly reports, contact assignments, personal feedback, SWOT analysis, final report & presentations related to your academic field of study or equivalent work experience

How much money do I have to bring with me?

As much as you need to supply yourself during whole program, at least \$500 CAD monthly.

Are internships paid?

In most cases internships are unpaid and they can't exceed 50% of the total program duration.

Do I need Insurance?

Yes, everyone is required to have at least health and accident insurance.

Do I need visa?

As per Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) guidelines, all candidates need a valid work visa (Working Holiday Visa, SWAP or Study and Work Permit (C30 Exemption) for the entire period of their internship. You can apply for your visa at your local Embassy of Canada.
